

Selection Process:

Step 1: Complete the Application Package and turn it in on time (Please check the date for the appropriate year)

- ✓ Application Form
- ✓ Introduction/Interest Paragraph
- ✓ 1 Academic, 1 Personal reference

Step 2: Candidate Review

- a. In-person meeting, or virtual if necessary (applicants will be provided the questions before the interview)
- b. Reference review- references may be contacted by the teacher
- c. Write and perform a 1-minute monologue, in person (by video if necessary).

Step 3: Candidate Selection

- Based on completed application
- Interview rubric score
- Monologue rubric score
- Draw process: 28 seats available

Step 4: Notification

All candidates will be notified of the final selection outcome – *please check the date for the appropriate year.*

*Monologue Instructions:

- I. Students are expected to write a one-minute monologue (something the character says on stage that no other character would hear, but is essentially the inner thoughts of the character for the audience to hear)
- II. Students should be in a costume for the character, as matches the monologue, and they can be any gender, but can only be an ethnicity that is culturally appropriate for them to play.
- III. Students will perform their monologue in character with other applicants from the grade range they are applying to.
