Places where student images and work may be seen or heard by the general public:

- School and department websites
- Government reports
- Media outlets (such as CBC, Whitehorse Star, Yukon News).

We are asking for your permission to use images of your child (photos, videos, sound) and of their school work for the kinds of communication described above. The Department of Education will follow the Yukon Schools *Web Publishing Guidelines* (attached) when using student images or work on its websites.

As well, we will make our best effort to prevent media outlets from accessing students and student work during school when permission has not been granted. This excludes designated public events such as concerts, plays, graduation ceremonies and inter-school sport competitions.

You may revoke your consent at any time. This revocation will not be retroactive.
